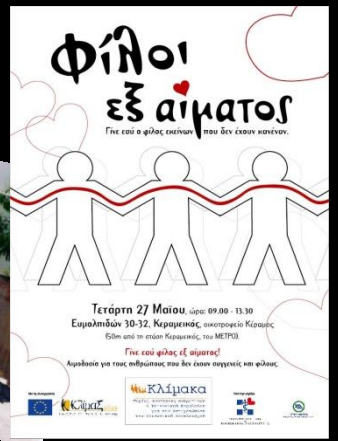

✓ *(consultancy, housing, training, occupational reintegration, legal support, etc)*

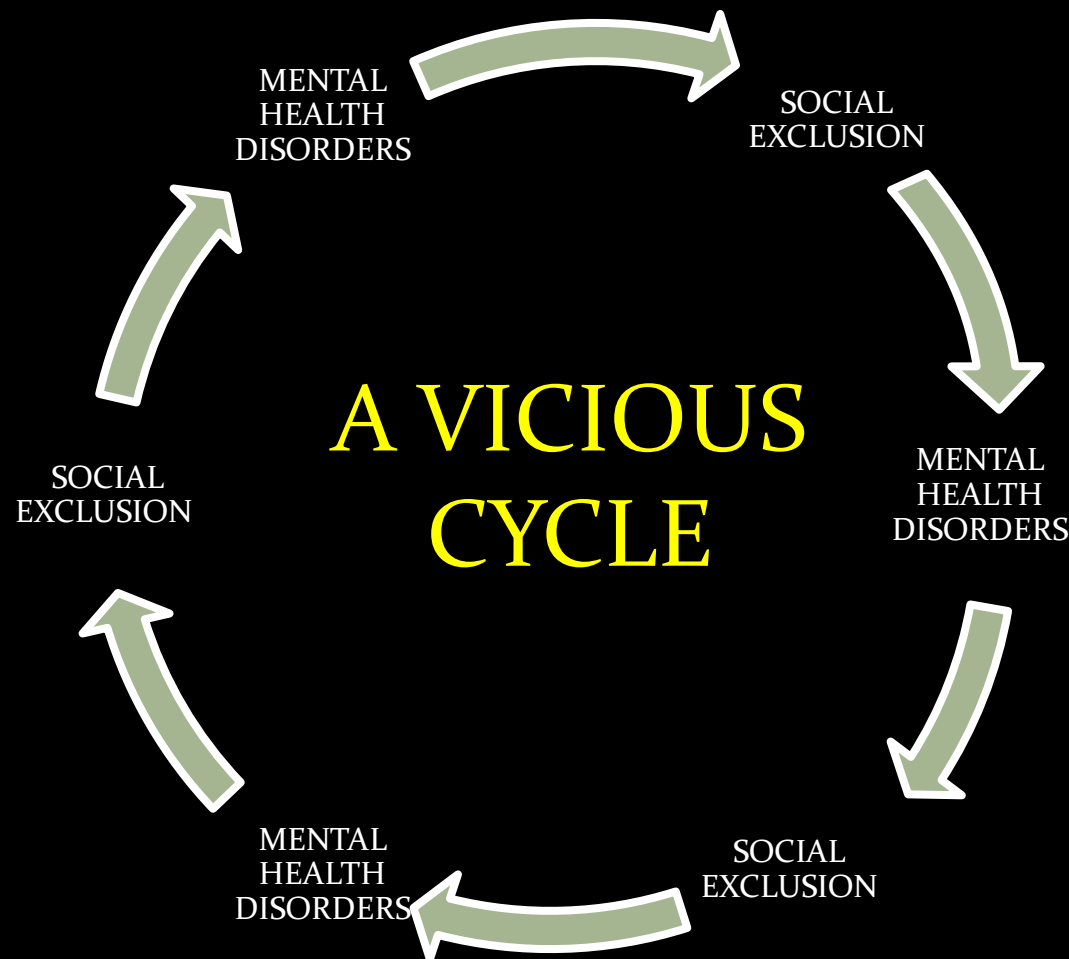

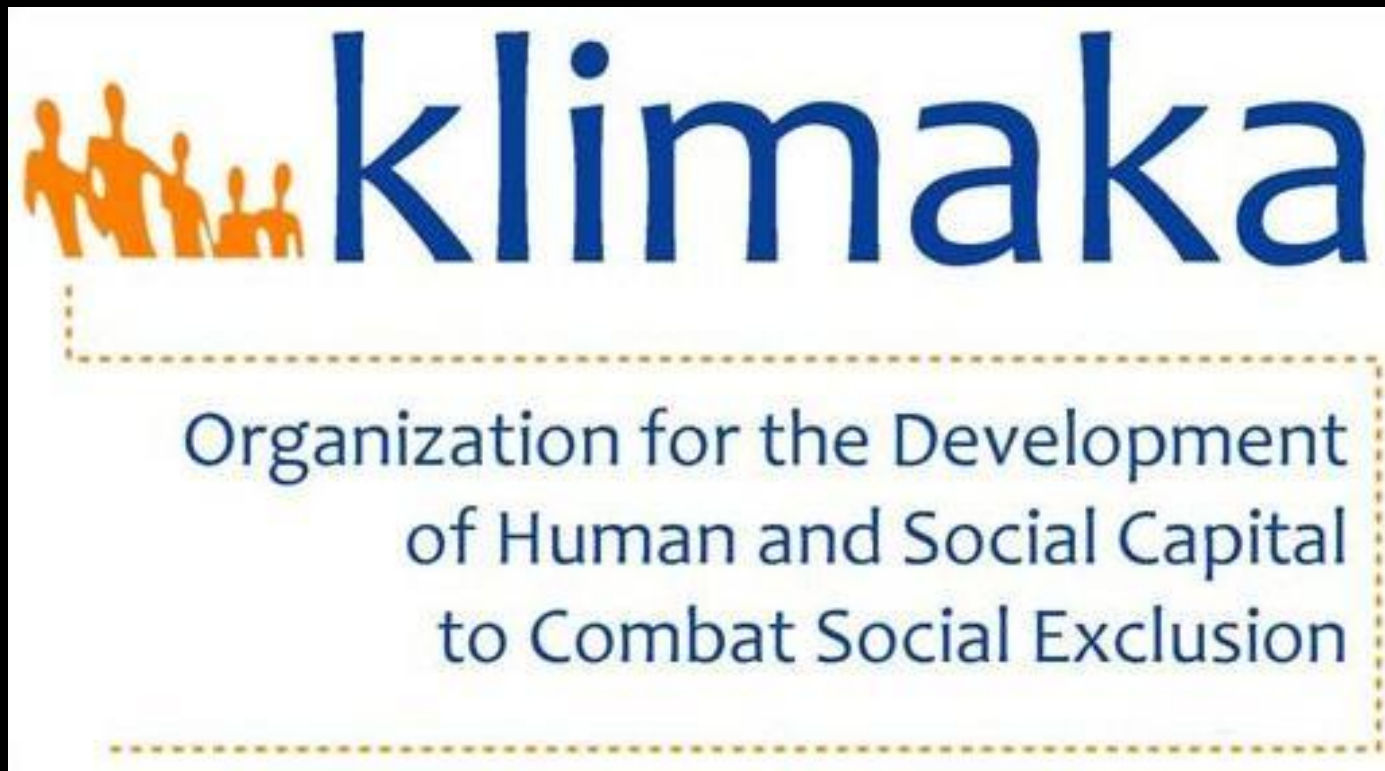

- Their equal integration in the society



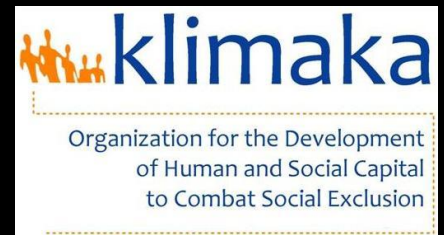
We encourage:
